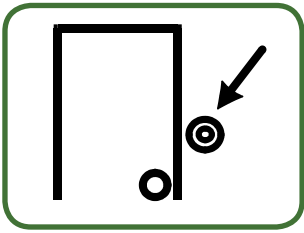

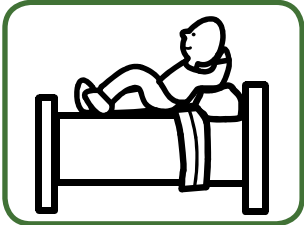
# Let's think about door alarms



## Why are there alarms?



- The alarms are there to keep service users and their things safe



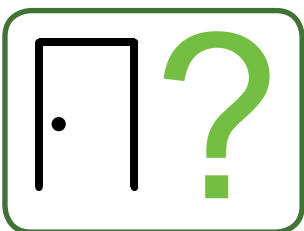
- Because there are alarms you do not need to lock your door when you are in your room

- You can relax



## When does the alarm go off?

- The alarm goes off when you leave your room or if anyone goes into your room



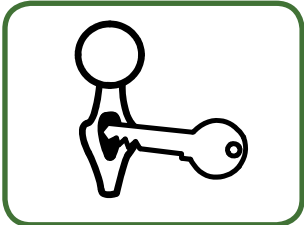
- The alarm tells staff which door has been opened

- If staff hear an alarm they will check to see if the service user is OK or needs help

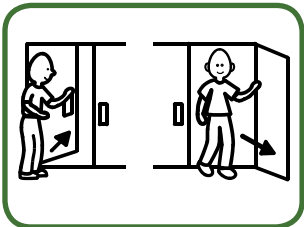


## Then what?

- You can lock your room when you go out to keep it private

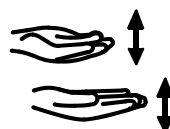


- You can come and go as you please

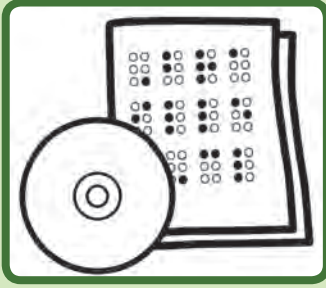

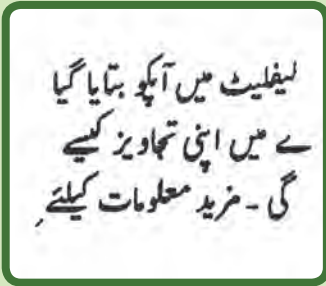
